Dental Plan Information Summary Sheet

Welcome! This is a summary sheet designed to provide some quick orientation about the teachers' dental plan.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Dental coverage is provided to teachers on a regular or temporary contract, their spouse and dependants to the age of 21 or 26, if attending an educational institution full time. Teachers receiving disability benefits under the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation Income Continuance Plan and/or the Teachers' Superannuation Plan are covered under the Plan.

- Dependent children are covered up to age 21 or up to age 26 if they are attending an educational institution full time.
- Student status must be indicated on the dental form or by the dentist if the dental claim is sent electronically at all times.
- Teachers on a temporary contract until June 30th, have dental coverage extended until August 31.
- Dental benefit ceases on the same day as the teachers' contract.
- To ensure the accurate processing of dental claims, teachers are required to use the Enrolment and Change of
 Information form to provide the necessary information to maintain accurate and current records for eligible
 teachers and their dependents. The Information Change form should be completed each time you have a change
 of information and forwarded to the Teachers' Superannuation Commission. Forms can be obtained through your
 School Board, STF or Saskatchewan Teachers' Superannuation Commission.

<u>Coverage</u>: The Plan provides Saskatchewan teachers and their dependants with coverage for Preventive, Routine and Major Restorative dental services. It also provides orthodontic services for dependant children and adults.

Level I – Preventive Services – 100% of the eligible charge.

Level II – Basic and Routine Services – 85% of the eligible charge.

Level III – Major Restorative Services – 60% of the eligible charge.

Level IV – Orthodontic Services – 50% of the eligible charge to the maximum of \$2000 per lifetime per individual.
